

COUNCIL MEMORANDA

The North Atlantic Council (NAC) issued about 1050 documents between mid-April 1952 and the end of 1958. These documents are described in paragraphs 262 through 271 of our first report, DES(92)1 (pages 69 - 72). And they are listed in Annex V-1 to that same report.

The Index Unit of the IS Registry has transferred information on each Council Memoranda (C-M) from index cards into a data base using a simple format with the following common elements (using the first of the 1959 Council Memoranda as an example):

Document/Reference number -

Date the document was issued -

Title, in each language version -

Annexed is a copy of the computer-generated listings of the 997 Council Memoranda issued between 1959 through 1965. The original microfilm roll numbers and the Index Unite roll numbers which contain the listed Council Memoranda are indicated. This is a continuation of the listing in Annex V-1, DES(92)1.

In the original filming the documents were arranged in numerical order except for the voluminous final report of the Annual Reviews for 1959 through 1964, which were filmed separately. All of the C-M documents were arranged in a single order with the English language version preceding the French language version. The Annual Review reports with their numerous addenda and corrigenda presented the indexers and those responsible for arranging the records for microfilming with numerous problems of presenting them in a logical sequence. The listing presented in the Annex may not represent the order in which the documents appear on the microfilm. Each part is identified in its title sufficiently to enable the user of the microfilm to determine which portion contains nationally provided information and analysis of national responses.

Most of the C-M have been downgraded from their original security classification and many are now NATO UNCLASSIFIED. The listing shows the present NATO security classification. The authority for the action is in the data base but has not been included in these listing to reduce the space taken for the listings.
