

EADRCC EXERCISE SITUATION REPORT N° 3 ON TERRORIST ATTACK IN ROMANIA

Exercise/Dacia 2003//

1. **The Command Post Exercise ended at 17:00 Brussels time.**
2. During the two day exercise, nineteen nations responded to the Request for Assistance from Romania distributed by the EADRCC at 08:30 on Monday 8 September 2003. Most of requirements for assistance were met by the offers from EAPC nations (see paragraph 3 for the latest update). The EADRCC would like to thank all in capitals for their active participation, and we hope to see you in October in Pitesti during the field exercise.
3. The following national contributions were communicated to the EADRCC
 - 3.1. Two detection teams, 20 men, SAR-teams and detection teams, 43 men, EOD-Team of 4 experts Austria Deployment on 9 September, 11.15, arrival in Pitesti 10 Sept 06.30
 - 3.2. 1 mobile unit with detection team Bulgaria Transportation by road, arrival 10 Sep
 - 3.3. Detection team, 5 vehicles Croatia Transportation TBD
 - 3.4. Detection team, Mobile laboratory for Radiation Monitoring Hungary Transportation TBD
 - 3.5. 3000 blankets, 400 stretchers, 30 tents, decontamination team; 2 power generator 22/380 each KVA Latvia Transportation TBD
 - 3.6. Tents, heating devices and dosimeters Lithuania Arrival in Romania 10 Sep 03 by aeroplane
 - 3.7. Tents, transportation capacity for other nations Luxembourg Transport by army truck, to arrive in Romania on 11 Sep 2003.
 - 3.8. Detection team, decontamination teams for personnel and vehicles Moldova Transportation TBD
