

1. With the report at reference, the EADRCC promulgated to National Points of Contact for International Disaster Assistance an initial request for assistance related to a possible emergency situation in Turkey.
2. Following the Turkish Request for Assistance, the EADRCC has matched this request with the content of the "Inventory of National Capabilities". Based on the findings, each country that might be a potential donor has been approached with the aim to obtain a picture of what might be offered. Most nations indicated that relevant national authorities are in the process of considering assistance. The EADRCC will continue to give follow-up and provide information in its situation reports.
3. To date, two nations (Croatia and Hungary) have informed the EADRCC of their offers for assistance. Details of these offers for assistance are provided in Annex 1 to this report. In addition, both Croatia and Hungary have indicated that they might have problems with the transportation of the goods. The EADRCC has been in contact with both nations to clarify their transportation requirement, with the aim to assist them when necessary by providing transport assistance from other nations.
4. Nations are therefore requested to examine whether they might be in a position to provide, **transportation capabilities** to assist the EADRCC in the coordination of the delivery of the assistance being offered.
5. Nations in a position to provide such transport capacity are invited to contact the Euro-Atlantic Disaster Response Coordination Centre at NATO HQ.
