


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## POSSIBLE EMERGENCY SITUATION IN TURKEY (Report Number 3 - 11 March 2003)

### 1. Situation

1.1. With the report at reference, the EADRCC promulgated to National Points of Contact for International Disaster Assistance an initial request for assistance related to a possible emergency situation in Turkey.

1.2. The request related to capabilities that might be needed by Turkish civil authorities to deal with the consequences of possible chemical or biological attacks against the civilian population (item 1 to 14) . In addition, the request included items (15 to 32) that might be needed to deal with the consequences of population movements towards Turkey.

1.3. Since the promulgation of the initial request, the Turkish authorities have reviewed their requirements to deal with the consequences of a possible chemical or biological attack, and have now also included equipment and material for the protection of Food and Water Supply Personnel.

1.4. The items 1 to 14 from the original request should be replaced by the items 1 to 37 listed in Annex 1. Please note that the requested assistance needed to deal with the consequences of population movement towards Turkey remains valid.

1.5. Since yesterday's report, the EADRCC has not received additional offers of assistance.

### 2. Transportation Hungarian Offer

2.1. As already indicated in the EADRCC report number 2, dated 10 March 2003, Hungary would like to receive assistance in the transportation of their offer. The volume of the goods to be transported is approximately 150 m<sup>3</sup> while the weight is approximately 13



tons. Pick-up point for this shipment is Budapest, the final destination is still under consideration by the Turkish authorities.

2.2. Nations in a position to assist Hungary in this transportation are invited to contact the EADRCC.
