

POSSIBLE EMERGENCY SITUATION IN TURKEY (Report Number 5 - 13 March 2003)

1. Situation

1.1. With the report at reference, the EADRCC promulgated to National Points of Contact for International Disaster Assistance an initial request for assistance related to a possible emergency situation in Turkey.

1.2. As of today, Canada, Croatia Hungary and Norway have informed the EADRCC of their offers of assistance to Turkey. Details of these offers are provided in Annex 1 to this report.

1.3. At Annex 2 to this report an overview is provided of the outstanding requirements for assistance from Turkey. This table covers the requirements to deal with the consequences of possible chemical or biological attacks against the civilian population as well as the assistance needed to deal with the consequences of population movements towards Turkey.

1.4. In our message EADRCC(2003)13 - dated 4 March 2003 information was provided on the Airports of Debarkation (APOD) and the Seaport of Debarkation (SPOD). Today the EADRCC has been informed that the port of Iskenderun no longer will be used as SPOD. Turkish authorities are now investigating alternative SPODs. The airports of Gaziantep and Van will continue to be used as APODs, with Erzurum as alternate.
