

## POSSIBLE EMERGENCY SITUATION IN TURKEY (Report Number 6 - 14 March 2003)

### 1. Situation

1.1. With the report at reference, the EADRCC promulgated to National Points of Contact for International Disaster Assistance an initial request for assistance related to a possible emergency situation in Turkey.

1.2. As of today, Canada, Croatia Hungary Norway and Poland have informed the EADRCC of their offers of assistance to Turkey. Details of these offers are provided in Annex 1 to this report.

1.3. Today, the EADRCC received an updated list of requirements for NBC equipment. Annex 2 to this report, which provides an overview of the outstanding requirements for assistance from Turkey, reflects the most recent update by Turkey. This table covers the requirements to deal with the consequences of possible chemical or biological attacks against the civilian population as well as the assistance needed to deal with the consequences of population movements towards Turkey.

1.4. Turkish authorities informed the EADRCC **that Vaccines against Smallpox and Anthrax, are the most urgent requirement.**

1.5. While the consignee for all the requested NBC equipment is the General Directorate of Civil Defence of the Ministry of the Interior, the consignee for the Smallpox and Anthrax Vaccines is the Ministry of Health.

1.6. For the requested NBC equipment Gaziantep Airport will be the entry point. The entry point for the Smallpox and Anthrax vaccines is Esenboga Airport in Ankara.

### 2. Transportation Request

2.1. Some of the nations offering assistance are not in a position to transport their offers of assistance. EAPC Nations are therefore requested to examine whether they might be in a position to provide, **transportation capabilities** to assist those nations with the delivery of the assistance being offered.
