

1. The Bulgarian authorities provided the EADRCC with the following updated information on the situation:

The situation in the disaster stricken parts of Bulgaria is very slowly returning to normal. Pumping and draining activities are still ongoing in residential buildings in the affected areas. As just reported from Sofia, Bulgaria is still in need of additional pumping capacity and sandbags as mentioned below.

Weatherforecast prognosticates sunny weather, however showers are expected in the mountain areas.

The following assistance left Sweden by truck on Saturday 11 June 2005, estimated date of arrival 15 June 05.

- 500 pcs. family tents
- 35 pcs. rubber boats
- 50.000 pcs. sand bags
