

1. The EADRCC received the request for assistance from the Emergency Situations and Civil Safety Service, MIA of Georgia 15.06.05 at 08:00.

Severe floods occurred in different regions in Georgia in April and May 2005. The Georgian authorities requested and received international assistance. The international operation ended on 26 May.

Following heavy rain in June the river Khevis-Ckhali in the Mckheta-Mtianeti region has flooded a considerable number of villages. There are casualties and missing people. Large numbers of houses are destroyed and agricultural areas are under water. Approximately 3600 people are isolated in Dushety and Kakheti region because the main roads are destroyed.

At this stage there is an urgent need for water purification equipment and food.
