

1. The EADRCC received the following report from the Emergency Situations and Civil Safety Service, MIA of Georgia 01.05.05 at 12:30:

"In disaster regions of Georgia by 10:00 of 1 May 2005 general condition is satisfactory. Population is fully evacuated from affected territory. Providing means of requisition, water and food is still in progress. Disaster consequence liquidation, mitigation and restoring activities are charring out well. Government special staff is detecting the scope of damage concerning each region.

Samekhe-Javakheti, (Borjomy) Zemo svanety, Samegrelo and Racha-lechkhumi (Shavi ghele teritori) regions are still in danger and possibilities of landslide in these areas are very high. Due to this, evacuation of additional 120 people are planning from dangerous zone."
