

1. The EADRCC received the following report from the Emergency Situations and Civil Safety Service, MIA of Georgia 05.05.05 at 11:00:

"In disaster regions situation retains dangerous. Because of heavy rains the level of water is still high. In Shida Kartli, Kalheti and Mtskhetsa-Mtianeti regions recurrent floods take place. The flood covers valleys, living houses, 2 km local road of high importance and 500 metres dam has seriously damaged.

Result of 25 - 28 April disaster still remains on dangerous levels. Due to bad weather the cleaning of roads is impossible. **Thousands of people are still disconnected from civilisation. Providing people of foods, materials of requisitions and medicaments are in priority.**"


