

1. The EADRCC has received information from the Emergency Situations and Civil Safety Service, MIA of Georgia about the floods in different parts of the country and distributed seven Situation Reports to EAPC nations. Several nations have provided assistance in response to the flooding and landslide damage.

The active assistance by the EADRCC to Georgia was suspended 13 May 2005. This final report gives a total overview of the humanitarian assistance provided through the Centre.
