

1. The EADRCC received the following information from the Emergency Situations and Civil Safety Service, MIA of Georgia 16.06.2005 at 12:30.

In Mckheta-Mtianeti region the situation has dramatically worsened. The whole area in Dushety has been flooded. Roads and bridges have been washed away. There are human casualties, massive loss of livestock, and large numbers of houses were destroyed. Destroyed roads hamper the evacuation of people.

Local resources are insufficient for helping affected population.
