

1. The EADRCC received the following information from the Emergency Situations and Civil Safety Service, MIA of Georgia 18.06.2005.

The situation in the Mckheta-Mtianeti region is still very serious even if the rescue personnel have managed to evacuate part of the population. In Dushety alone more than 130 houses are totally damaged. Rescue personnel have also been able to distribute food and some clothing to the affected population, but the need for further assistance still remains. The requirements for assistance are adjusted accordingly. Distribution of food and evacuation of the population are hampered by the destroyed roads.

Local resources are insufficient for helping affected population.
