

1. The EADRCC received the following updated information from the Emergency Situations and Civil Safety Service, MIA of Georgia on 27 June 2005.

The situation for the affected population is still serious. Especially food and drinking water is needed. Austria has offered 20 portable water tanks, but there is no transportation available, **ref. the request for transportation, OPS(EADRCC)(2005)0043.**

The weather forecast for the next days is heavy rain and the water level is expected to rise.

The need for international assistance is still urgent.

2. The following requirements for assistance are still outstanding:

2.6.	Diesel generators (2-5KW)	ASAP	10 pcs
2.7.	Personal hygienic equipment	ASAP	6300 pcs
2.10.	Clothing	ASAP	for 1500 persons

- 3.2 **Czech Republic** 67.000 Euro through UN-WFP
- 3.3 **Austria** 20 portable watertanks *(not delivered yet, please see still valid EADRCC urgent request for transport assistance OPS (EADRCC)(2005)0034*
- 3.4 **Germany and France** 13,8 tons flour (purchased locally)
