

1. The EADRCC has received information from the Emergency Situations and Civil Safety Service, MIA of Georgia about the latest floods in different parts of the country and distributed five Situation Reports to EAPC nations. Three nations have provided assistance in response to the flooding and landslide damage. Regarding the request for transportation of 20 portable water tanks - OPS(EADRCC)(2005)0043, the Austrian authorities organised the delivery in cooperation with the Austrian Red Cross.

The active assistance by the EADRCC to Georgia was suspended 01 July 2005. There is, however, still a need for financial support for the reconstruction of the flood affected area.

The following humanitarian assistance has been offered and delivered to Georgia:
