

1. In order to facilitate the delivery of the requested relief items, the Romanian authorities have identified the following points of entry:

1.1 International Airport Timisoara, Timis County

1.2 International Airport Henri Coanda, Bucharest

1.3 Border crossing points are CENAD and NADLAC at the Hungarian border. These are the closest border crossing points to the most affected areas in Timis county.

3. **Assistance provided**

3.1 The following assistance has been offered to the stricken country:



Luxembourg

3.1.1	Diving suits	17
3.1.2	Diving compressed air tanks	16
3.1.3	Various diving accessories	

3.2 The above-listed relief items will be transported from Luxembourg by air on 20 May 2005. Estimated time of arrival (ETA) at Timisoara: 00.45 21 May 2005.

Austria

3.2.1	Submersible water pumps (3000-5000 l/min)	9
3.2.2	Submersible water pumps (1500 l/min)	10
3.2.3	Power generators (125 kVA)	2
3.2.4	Cable traction devices (5000 kg force)	7
3.2.5	Personnel	70

3.3 The convoy consists of 15 trucks. Estimated time of departure (ETD): 21.00 20 May 2005. ETA: 07.00 21 May 2005.

3.4 Hungary informed the EADRCC that responding to an earlier request from the Romanian authorities the following assistance has already been provided for Romania in two phases on bilateral basis:

Hungary

3.4.1	High capacity water pumps (500 l/sec)	10
3.4.2	Operating personnel for one month	65
3.4.3	Water purification unit (4500l/hour) as of 18 May	1
3.4.4	Operating personnel for two weeks	14

3.5 Germany has also deployed THW Teams with pumping and water purification equipment to Romania on bilateral basis. The German team can be contacted via the following numbers: +49 173 294 0831 or +49 172 250 5835

3.6 Furthermore, the Czech Republic, Poland, Slovak Republic and Slovenia informed the EADRCC that they were considering the possibility of providing Romania with the requested assistance.
