

1. The Romanian General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations has reassessed the situation in the flood stricken Timis county taking into consideration the international assistance provided as of 211000 Z MAY 2005:

2. The following international assistance is still required:

3. **Assistance provided**

3.1 The following assistance has been offered to the stricken country:

### **Luxembourg**

3.1.1	Diving suits	17
3.1.2	Diving compressed air tanks	16
3.1.3	Diving accessories	various



3.2 The above-listed relief items have been shipped by air on 20 May 2005.

**Austria**

3.2.1	Submersible water pumps (3000 – 5000 litres per minute)	9
3.2.2	Submersible water pumps (1500 litres per minute)	20
3.2.3	Power generators 125 kVA	2
3.2.4	Cable traction devices 5 tons force capacity	7
3.2.5	Personnel	45

3.3 The assistance has been dispatched in 2 convoys of 20 vehicles altogether, estimated time of arrival in Timisoara/RO 21 May 2005 between 15:00 and 17:00 hours local.

**Hungary**
