

1. The Romanian General Inspectorate for Emergency Situations has provided the following updated information about the situation in the stricken area:

1.1 The flooded area measures approximately 70 square kilometres and some 5700 houses are affected and destroyed. Floods are receding and the water level is now 0,4 metres in some areas due to the efficient work done by the intervention teams. The teams from Finland, France and Hungary are still pumping water from flooded areas at the Otelec and Graniceri dikes under LEMA co-ordination and in close cooperation with Romanian intervention teams. Local authorities are in the process of assessing the condition of flooded houses in order to prepare for reconstruction. Pest control activities are ongoing.

1.2 Weather forecasts announce clear weather for the next two days; temperatures will range between 10 and 28 degrees centigrade.
