

1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received today, 14 February 2006, a disaster assistance request from UNHCR via UN-OCHA (CMCS)

The following information was provided.

2. General Situation

Type of the Disaster : **FLOODS**
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : **10-11 February 2006**
Location of the Disaster : **Province Tindouf, Algeria, 50-60 kms from Moroccan and Mauritanian borders**

3. Initial Assessment of the damage and description of the situation.

3.1. On 10-11 February very heavy rain caused flooding in the region of Tindouf, Algeria in the region of Tindouf in an area with a refugee village constructed from mud bricks and has been destroyed by the flood water, affecting reportedly 12,000 families, although no exact figures can be given yet. **The Algerian government has requested emergency humanitarian assistance.**

3.2. 1 or 2 persons have died, major need is tents and food

4. National resources available for disaster response and measures taken.

4.1. Algerian army has delivered 7.000 tents

4.2. Local UNHCR, WFP and Algerian Red Crescent representatives have evaluated extent of casualties, damage and immediate needs.
