

1. Situation update:

1.1 An estimate of 50.000 people have been left homeless after torrential rains and following flooding devastated camps around Tindouf in Algeria.

1.2 The EADRCC has received on 14 February 2006 a disaster assistance request from UNHCR through UN-OCHA for fixed wing strategic airlift to move 2.000 tents from Amman to Tindouf.

1.3 The Algerian governmental agencies and red Crescent are mobilized and have been coordinating the response.

2. UNHCR advises that an additional request for air-lift support is in preparation and that additional aircraft will be urgently needed to transport more relief goods from Amman, Jordan to Tindouf, Algeria; details will be confirmed as soon as they become available.
