

1. Situation update:

- 1.1 During the last 3 days, the Danube River water level of the whole Bulgarian part has shown a permanent decreasing tendency. In some stations the levels vary.
- 1.2 In all effected municipalities dykes are permanently observed. Activities for pumping out water are being conducted. The necessary epidemic prevention measures are taken. Plans have been developed for allocation of forces and means concerning draining of private and municipal buildings after recession of subterranean water. Samples for analysis of drinking water from water mains and shallow water of the Danube River have been taken. No discrepancies have been registered so far.
- 1.3 The declared "Disaster Situation" in the Municipalities along the Danube River still remains.
- 1.4 The authorities continuously provide food and drinking water to 239 persons, isolated in villages Botevo and Simeonovo, as well as evacuated people in Nikopol and Kozloduy.
