


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**EADRCC SITUATION REPORT N° 4.
Assistance to Kyrgyz Republic after Heavy Snowfall**



1. Situation update:

- 1.1 In January and February 2006 heavy snowfall caused severe damages in Southern Kyrgyzstan, namely in Osh and Jalalabat Provinces.
- 1.2 As a result, 4 people were killed; 1.118 settlements were affected (800 in Osh and 271 in Jalalabat regions); 17 public houses and farmlands were totally destroyed in Osh region. 86 public houses (47 in Osh, 16 in Jalalabat regions) were destroyed; 1815 private houses (1248 in Osh and 563 in Jalalabat regions) damaged. 63 schools and hospitals (50 in Osh, 13 Jalalabat regions) were affected; the damaged length of highways is 258 km (146 in Osh, 112 in Jalalabat province); the length of damaged power grids in the country is 48 km (30 in Osh, 18 in Jalalabat regions).
- 1.3 AUSTRIA, HUNGARY, ROMANIA, SLOVAK REPUBLIC, SPAIN, RUSSIAN FEDERATION and **TURKEY informed the EADRCC, that assistance has been or will be provided.**

The first truck, with 20 tons of donations from Austria and Hungary, transportation funded by UN-OCHA, has arrived on 05 April 2006 in Bishkek.

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- 1.4 The remaining donations from Slovakia and Romania could be transported by train. The transportation from Slovakia will cost approximately 3.100 Euro, the transportation from Romania approximately 20.000 Euro
- 1.5 Nations are invited to finance the transport. Funding arrangement could be made through the EADRCC.




