

1. Situation update:

- 1.1 The situation in Finland remains mostly unchanged. Because of damage to the computer networks, metropolitan telephone services operate only intermittently. The thunderstorms also caused emergency civil defence warning sirens to go off, resulting in public confusion. The lack of radio transmission in the metropolitan area means that no public information about false alarms can be relayed. Emergency rescue services are unable to handle the volume of emergency calls.
- 1.2 Finland is employing the following own resources: USAR Team, two CBRN Units, one CBRN Unit (military), Special Fire and Rescue Unit (Navy), four Water Purification Units (Red Cross)
- 1.3 All International teams have arrived and are preparing for their deployments.
- 1.4 Deployment of the NATO Rapid Reaction Team (RRT) has been authorised by SCEPC. RRT's Team Leader is Mr. Harald Kalvoy, FAPC expert from Norway.


