

1. Situation update:

1.1. According to the latest report from Moldova, the situation is worsening in the country. Already, 7944 people are evacuated from 12 regions. Eight regions are still under the threat of evacuation. About 500 wells are affected. In Briceni region, 4 water supply systems are affected. Water pump station is flooded in Edinet region. In Dubasarii Vechi region the water pump station is under the threat of being flooded. The water is continuously rising on Prut river.

1.2. The Moldovian Government has involved in the rescue operations: 368 rescuers, 332 militaries, 440 carabineers, 180 police officers and 192 vehicles.

1.3. The Government of Republic of Moldova responded with the different kind of goods of first need in all the affected regions.
