

1. Situation update:

1.1. In the North part of the country the situation is under control and evacuated people are returning to their homes.

1.2. The situation is still difficult in the Shtefan Voda region (in 5 villages: Talmaz, Olanesti, Crocmaz, Tudora and Palanca) in the South part of the country along the river Nistru. There are 4130 evacuated people and 879 flooded houses at Nistru river, while there are 4041 evacuated people, 401 flooded houses at Prut river.

1.3. In the Shtefan Voda region 500 persons (rescuers, militaries, carabinieri) and 34 vehicles are working on strengthening of the dikes, which are still in danger.

1.4. National authorities are taking measures on elimination of the consequences of the flood.
