

### 1. Situation update:

1.1. The situation in the stricken areas of the country is under control and evacuated people return to their houses. The water pumping process continues.

1.2. Because of probable epidemiological problems there is an urgent necessity to clean up the territories where the flood waters have receded.

1.3. More than 200 persons (rescuers, militaries and carabineers) and 33 vehicles are working to restore vital services.

### 2. International assistance is still urgently required:

#### 2.1. The following assistance is required (1<sup>st</sup> being the highest priority):

The EU MIC is heavily involved in managing the consequences in the stricken country by facilitating offers of the EU member states, which are listed above. In addition, the EU MIC has dispatched an expert team to Chisinau to facilitate the incoming European assistance, liaise with other partners and help the Government to identify further needs.
