

1. Situation update:

- 1.1 523 settlements and 9010 houses are still flooded in six regions in Western Ukraine, in particular, in Ivano-Frankivsk, Lviv, Vinnytsya, Chernivtsi, Zakarpattya, and Ternopil regions. The water has been drained from 261 settlement (38660 houses). Ukraine's Emergency Minister stated that 23 people had drowned, three had been hit by lightning, three had been electrocuted and one was killed by a landslide.
- 1.2 Ukrainian parliament responded with the allocation of some 5.8 billion UAH (\$1.2 billion) to disaster relief efforts.
