

1. Situation update:

1.1 As far as the weather forecast is concerned, rains are expected in the Western regions of Ukraine. Heavy rains are probable on 4-5 August 2008. In the mountainous areas of Carpathian region there is still a threat of land-slides. In case of heavy rains the water level in rivers may rise, which may worsen the situation.

2. Resources available for disaster response and measures taken:

2.1 Ukraine has involved its 2550 rescuers and 564 vehicles in the rescue operations.

2.2 President of Ukraine Victor Yushchenko has signed a law, which will help to overcome the natural disaster consequences in six Oblasts of Ukraine affected by the flood.

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3. Assistance offered/provided by EAPC Nations:
