

1.Situation update:

1.1Four towns are still flooded.

1.2The water-pumping works, repair works and restoration works continue. The hygiene and epidemiological service provides constant control over the epidemic situation in the area.

1.3The population in the area is being constantly informed about the measures taken.

2.Resources available for disaster response and measures taken:

2.1There is about 25 thousand personnel, 5 thousand vehicles, 393 pumps and 69 units of engineer equipment engaged.
