

### 1. Situation update.

1.1. The Tajik government has said heavy rain between 20 April and 15 May caused flooding and mud flows in 25 of the country's 58 districts, leaving over 21 people dead. Some 14,000 hectares of agricultural land had been damaged and 3,600 people had lost their homes, according to the Ministry of Agriculture, with Khatlon and Sughd provinces worst hit.

**5. Assistance provided by nations:**

5.1. **Austria** is considering at the moment an offer for assistance to Tajikistan consisting of tents and power generators (details tbd).

5.2. The **Slovak Republic** has offered the humanitarian material aid consisting of 10 tents for 150 people and 10 mobile generators 3 kVA.

5.3. The **German** Federal Office of Civil Protection and Disaster Assistance has informed the EADRCC that the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Technische Zusammenarbeit (GTZ) GmbH has provided US \$ 30.000 for emergency relief items.
