

1. Situation update.

1.1. According to the Tajik Government more than 2000 buildings have been destroyed. More than 28 people have been killed, including 10 children. More than 10000 people are displaced.

1.2. The Khuroson district of Khatlon province is the most affected area, where almost 3000 people are displaced, 305 of the displaced families are sheltered in two tented camps provided by the Government. The rest of the displaced people have been sheltered by friends and relatives.

1.3. There are damages in transport and agricultural infrastructure.

5. Assistance provided by nations:

5.1. **Austria** has offered the 40 tents (each for up to 10 persons, with additional equipment), 26m³, 6 tons, packed on 12 pallets.

5.2. The **Slovak Republic** has offered humanitarian aid material consisting of 10 tents for 150 people, 4 mobile generators 3 kVA and 2 tonnes of medicines.

6. Information on transportation:

6.1. The plane (Antonov AN-12) is expected to arrive in Wien/Schwechat on 29th May 2009.
