

1. Situation update.

1.1. According to the Tajik Government the Khuroson district has been flooded two times and relocation camps were set up April 21st and May 16th. In the result of the disaster more than 300 buildings/houses were fully destroyed and some partially but with damaged structures, so that they have to be completely rebuilt. The people could only rescue their lives but none of their belongings during the evacuation phase.

1.2. The overall number of relocated people is 2.670 in Khuroson. Two schools are flooded. Since the hospital in Khuroson has been hit by a mudslide it will not be usable for months.

1.3. The government plans to move the people from the relocations camps to the reconstruction sites (No.1 – 18ha for 114 houses and No.2 – 43ha for 220 houses), where their new houses shall be built.

1.4. According to the Tajik Government 18000 persons don't have access to drinkable water supply. 3600 persons (according to REACT) have been displaced. 30 people have been killed.

5. Assistance provided by nations:

5.1. The **Austrian** offer of 40 tents (10 persons/each) and the **Slovak** aid of 10 tents (15 persons/each), 4 power generators (3KVA) and medication arrived by plane in Dushanbe on 30 May. The assistance from Austria and the Slovak Republic was provided through the EU Civil Protection Mechanism. The European Commission has granted co-financing of up to 50% of the transportation cost from Vienna to Dushanbe.

5.2. The EADRCC has been informed that the following allocations were done by:

- **UN-OCHA** – 118250 USD for purchase of tents, fuel for water tinkering and household items;
- **IFRC** – 118472 USD for non food items;
- **GTZ** – 30000 USD for emergency relief items;
- **France Embassy** in Dushanbe – 20000 EUR through the Red Crescent Society of Tajikistan;
- Government of **Uzbekistan** – Construction materials, food items and tents;
- The **EU Commission** will request the approval of 300000 EUR for provision of non food items and rehabilitation of water supply systems for the affected populations of the natural disaster.
