

1. Situation update:

1.1 November 17 preliminary tests reveal no significant changes in the pandemic (H1N1) 2009 virus based on investigations of samples taken from patients in Ukraine. Analyses are being performed by two WHO influenza collaborating centres as part of the global influenza surveillance network.

1.2 As of 0800hrs November 15, according to the information from the Ministry of Health of Ukraine, the total number of people who fell ill with influenza and acute respiratory diseases reached **1.347.538**.

1.3 Altogether **73.373** people have been taken to the hospitals.

1.4 As the result of the epidemic situation **282** people have died.

1.5 The largest number of illnesses has been registered in Lviv, Ternopil, Ivano-Frankivsk, Chernivtsy, Rivne, Chernigiv, Zakarpattya, Khmelnytskyi, Volyn, Zhytomyr, Kiev, Donetsk, Vinnitsa, Micholaiv, Luhansk, Khirovohrad, Sumy, Poltava, Zaporizgya, Chercassy Oblasts and Kiev.
