

### 1. Situation update according to information received by Albania

1. The number of persons evacuated from the flood-affected regions in north-west Albania as of yesterday night are 4,780 persons The number of families being evacuated daily is 572 Still there are 1137 families at risk The number of houses flooded (in whole or in part) stands at 2,408.  
A total of 10,400 ha of farmland is flooded. Because of serious damages to the water supply system, many in the flooded communities don't have access to drinking water. There are damages to agricultural and transport infrastructure, making the area around Shkodra only accessible by small boats. Number of families at risk are 1137
2. The remaining families in the risk area, but in safe houses are 467, and there are 98 families in the area with high risk.  
People accommodated at reception centers are now 561 persons

## **2. Undertaken measures and government response**

The Albanian Government has declared “the status of civil emergency” and has established the Inter- ministerial Committee.

Emergency staff of Shkodra Prefecture has drawn up and implemented evacuation plan for each Local Government Units.

For the evacuation of the population and livestock, repair of embankment, the distribution of aid and the provision of road crossings by Armed Forces are committed 938 and 219 means of transport forces

### **Ground Troops and equipments are dislocated:**

More than 2000 troops from the institution below are operational on the field engaged on the different tasks: evacuation, foods & water distribution, transport, control of territory, improvement of situation at the dams, etc

- Armed forces,
- State police
- Electric Energetic Corporate
- Drainage boards
- Teams of firefighters department, rescue
- General Directorate of Roads
- Ministry of Health, etc.



### **3. International assistance offered and accepted:**

According to the EU MIC the following nations have offered assistance to

Albania:

Greece: 2 groups of firefighters of the Hellenic Fire Service with equipment (29

Fire-fighters, 4 vehicles, 2 rescue boats, 22 water pumps)

Slovenia: 13 mobile power generators

France: 11 water pumps with drain pipes (Honda 30.000lit/h)

Italy: 2 CH47 of the Italian Army, transport capacity 20 personnes each, Medicines  
(antibiotics, paracetamol, etc

### **4. According to information given to EADRCC from The Italian Delegation to**

**NATO, the following support will be given to Albania:**

- 500 kitchen sets for five persons;
- 4400 blankets;
- 2300 Jerry cans;
- 3 wheel-mount diesel generators (15 Kva);
- 5 wheeel-mount diesel generators (10 kva);
- 7 lamp diesel generators (5 kva);
- 7 water tanks (3500 lit capacity)
- 5 water tanks (7500 lit capacity);
- 8 diesel wheel-mount water pumps;
- 6 inflatable life boats with full equipment;
- 5 (32 sq mt ) cold climate tents;
- 82 (22 sq mt) cold climate tents;
- 720 high energy biscuits (package of 10 kgs)

The goods will be delivered on January 14.
