Situation

1. Due to the situation in the Kyrgyz Republic over the past several months, the interim government of the Kyrgyz Republic requested that NATO Civil Emergency Planning (CEP) distribute requirements of medicines and medical equipment for use in emergencies to national Points of Contact. References A through F apply. Today, CEP has received a fourth request for assistance in the area of medical and food aid.

2. In his letter to NATO of 14 June 2010, the Ambassador, Head of the Mission of Kyrgyzstan to NATO stated in part: "The recent unrest in the southern part of Kyrgyzstan, particularly in the southern capital of the country Osh town, has led to a loss of almost one hundred lives and thousands injured. As a result of widespread clashes between Kyrgyz and Uzbek ethnic groups, thousands of people were forced to leave their homes in Osh town. No shops are open. People do not have food to eat. The provisional government is trying its best to stabilise the situation. However, the provisional government does not have adequate resources to achieve this. In this situation, Kyrgyztan is forced to seek international assistance of humanitarian medical and food aid."
