

1. **Situation update:**

1.1 According to the Moldovan authorities the situation in the flooded areas is under control. The level of water is decreasing day by day.

1.2 As a consequence of flooding, 2 persons died, about 3 460 persons were evacuated and about 622 houses were flooded, about 200 houses were destroyed.

1.3 The floods affected about 40 000 ha of agricultural lands, destroyed 24 bridges, 113 wells, 182 km of roads, 10 dams, 796 ha of forest and number of educational and administrative buildings.

2. **There is no longer request for further international assistance.**

3. **Assistance provided/offered by EAPC Nations:**

3.1 On 19th of July the Federal State Hesse (**Germany**) delivered to Chisinau 30 000 sandbags (60x30cm).

3.2 The Embassy of **Germany** in Romania has provided Moldovan Civil Protection Emergency Situation Service (CPESS) with life vests, trousers and rubber boots. The EU CP team facilitated the hand over to the CPESS of that assistance.

3.3 The EADRCC has been informed that the Government of the **State of Israel** donated 1000 blankets and 13 tents. The donation value is 20.000 EUR.

3.4 Following the immediate request by World Health Organization, the **Italian Government** has granted an Inter Agency Emergency Kit (IEHK) (appr. USD15000) to assist the populations hit by the floods of the Prut River. This contribution will bring medical care to approximately 10 000 people over a period of three months. The kit is being provided by the Humanitarian Deposit (UNHRD) located in Brindisi, Italy, and was shipped by an airplane to Chisinau at the beginning of this week. Upon destination it will be presented to the WHO Representative in Chisinau, Ms. Irina Prodan (27 Sfatul Tarii Str. - Office 37-38, 2012 - Chisinau, Tel. + 37322237348/+37322237346), who will be responsible for delivering the goods.

3.5 The **Unites States of America** will provide \$50,000 to the International Federation of the Red Cross to provide emergency relief supplies in Moldova.

3.6 **Georgia** offered to send the Rescue team (23 persons) with 3 water pumps and 3000 litres of drinking water. This offer was not accepted by Moldovan authorities.

3.7 The following assistances have been provided to Moldova through EU – Civil Protection Mechanism:

– **Austria:**

- 31.000 sand bags (PP/ polypropylene, dimension 40 x 70 cm) packed on 4 EURO pallets LxWxH = 1.200x800x1.200 mm, weight: 1.200kg;
- 3.840 m² PE plastic sheets/tarpaulins containing of 96 pieces each 10x4 m, thickness 0,2 mm packed on 2 EURO pallets LxWxH = 1.200x800x1.200 mm, weight: 590 kg.

– **Estonia:**

- 5 water pumps (expecting to deliver);
- 5 power generators (expecting to deliver);
- 2 motor boats;
- Food, clothes and other humanitarian assistance for stricken population for total value of USD15000.

– **Romania:**

- 20 kits of well cleaning systems;
- 10 inflatable boats with 26 rescuers;
- 30 000 sandbags;
- 15 000 m² polyethylene film;
- 20 tons of bottled mineral water;
- 1 water purification unit.
