

1. Situation update:

- 1.1 The situation in Chernivtsi oblast is under control.
- 1.2 More than 13 800 wells, including 4 884 flooded wells have been sanitized. As a result of ground water upheaval there is a need for repeated pumping works in 1 580 wells and 1 084 basements.
- 1.3 The measures in providing population with drinking water in Sadhirsky region of Chernivtsi have been taken.
- 1.4 In total UAH 402 100 from local budgets have been dedicated to deal with consequences of the disaster. UAH 1.5 million and more than 1 million Euros have been received as charitable contributions. UAH 1.4 million subventions have been received from budgets of other oblasts.

The EADRCC is inviting EAPC nations to offer/provide additional assistance to Ukraine on bilateral basis.

3. Assistance provided/offered by EAPC Nations:

3.1 The **Russian Federation** airlifted on July 1 and 2, 2010 the following relief items to the city of Ivanovo-Frankovsk:

The value of assistance is about USD 806 000.
