

1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, NATO has received today, 7 August 2010, a request for assistance from **PAKISTAN**. The permission for the EADRCC to deal with this situation was approved by NAC on 5<sup>th</sup> August. The following information has been provided.

### 2. General Situation

Type of the Disaster : **FLOODS**  
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : **27-29 July 2010**  
Location of the Disaster : **Pakistan**

3. Initial assessment of the damage and description of the situation.

3.1. The total number of flood-affected people is now estimated at more than 4 million. Monsoon rains continue to fall and at least 11 districts are at risk of flooding.

3.2. According to the latest National Disaster Management Authorities (NDMA) figures, over 252 000 houses are thought to be damaged or destroyed across the affected provinces.

3.3. Many northern districts are still largely cut off from the rest of the country.

3.4. A 7-member UNDAC team deployed to Pakistan on request from the UN Resident Coordinator on 7<sup>th</sup> August.
