

1. Situation update:

1.1 The monsoon rains have so far affected over 5.4 million people or some 1 million households. A total of 665,821 houses have been damaged of which 54% are fully destroyed.

1.2 The number of deaths has increased to 347 in the past six weeks, according to the NDMA report.


1.3 72.65 % of the crops in the province of Sindh have been damaged or destroyed while 36.2% of livestock has been lost or sold.

1.4 Out of 824,000 displaced people, 66% are currently living in temporary settlements. 20.4% affected people are living in open air, 34.1% use plastic sheets as shelter and only 0.2% are living in houses.

3. Assistance provided through EU-Mechanism:

3.1. Austria offered assistance consisting of 3.010.000 “Aquatabs 167 mg” water purification tablets (each tablet to purify appr. 20 litres of water) and 300 winterized family tents (4x4 m UNHCR Specifications – good for a 5/6 persons family).

4. United States Agency of International Development has contributed \$100,000 for non food items, water, sanitation, and hygiene activities (WASH) – specifically plastic sheets, rope, Aquatabs and jerry cans on bilateral basis.
