

1. In accordance with the procedures at reference, EADRCC has received on, 06 September 2012, a disaster assistance request from Jordan dated 06 September 2012 13:08 UTC. The following information was provided.

2. General Situation

Type of the Disaster : **Flow of Syrian refugees into Jordan**
Date and Time the Disaster occurred : **During the last months**
Location of the Disaster : **Jordan side of the Syrian border**

3. Initial Assessment of the situation.

3.1. The UNHCR said on 4 September 2012 that the number of refugees fleeing Syria rose sharply in August, with 103,416 people seeking asylum in surrounding countries. It was the highest monthly total of the Syria crisis to date and brought the total number of Syrian refugees registered or awaiting registration to more than 235,300.

3.2. In Jordan, refugees continue to arrive at a rate of about 1,000 a day. Some 10,200 people arrived in the seven days between August 21-27, compared to 4,500 the previous week. More than 22,000 people have been received at the Za'atri camp since it opened on July 30.

3.3. Due to the considerable increase in number of refugees, the Jordan authorities have decided to accept offers by the international community to share the burden.


