Change of Command ceremony and relocation of Hungarian troops by Commander KFOR, General Erhard Bühler

On Tuesday the 1st of March 2011 Commander KFOR, General Erhard Bühler will conduct Change of Command of the Hungarian Contingent in Camp "SLIM LINES" in Pristina.

The Command of the Hungarian Contingent in Kosovo will be handed over from Lt. Colonel László KANYÓ to Lt. Colonel Sandor SZABO.

On the same occasion General Bühler, will officially order the relocation of the Hungarian Company into the Tactical Maneuvers Reserve Battalion of KFOR (KTM).

The ceremony will start at 14.45 hours in Camp "SLIM LINES".

Immediately after the ceremony a press point will be held by Commander KFOR, General Erhard BÜHLER to illustrate the importance of the current event in the context of the new forces structure of KFOR from the 1st of March on.
