Pristina University and the German University of Sigmaringen sign a Cooperation Agreement.

German Delegation meets Minister of Foreign Affairs Enver Hoxhaj.

On Thursday the 23rd of June 2011, in Pristina, the Ceremony for the signing of a Cooperation Agreement, between Pristina University and the German University of Sigmaringen will take place.

The agreement, honored by the presence of Commander of KFOR, Maj. Gen. **Erhard Bühler**, will be signed by the Rector Prof. Dr. **Mujë Rugova** and the Vice Rector Prof. Dr. **Markus Lehmann**.

The ceremony will be held at the Senate Hall of Pristina University, starting at 11:15.

Before this event the German delegation from Sigmaringen will have a meeting with the representatives of the Chamber of Commerce of Kosovo. Economic relationship between the economically strong Region of Sigmaringen in the German Federal State of Baden-Württemberg and the Kosovar economy will be discussed. There could be a lot of opportunities to build up cooperation between companies or joint ventures.

A most important meeting after the conference in the Chamber of Commerce will be with

Foreign Minister **Enver Hoxhaj**

in the Ministry for Foreign Affairs.

An exchange of views between Minister Hoxhaj, General Bühler and the German delegation is on the agenda, as well as the evaluation of opportunities of the German delegation to improve the position and the reputation of Kosovo in Germany, especially in



Baden-Württemberg in the South West of Germany. It is already the result of the efforts and the stance of the present Commander KFOR, General Erhard Bühler, that more and more German multipliers in politics and the economy especially in the South west part of Germany are interested in Kosovo and the perspective of the Kosovar people.

A Press Point will be offered at the end of the Ceremony.
