COMMANDER KFOR: KFOR DOES NOT ACCEPT ANY VIOLENCE

Pristina 25/26 of July 2011

Commander KFOR General Erhard Bühler appeals to all the citizens of Kosovo not to react violently to the present situation in the North or at the crossing points at the Administrative Boundary Line to Serbia: “KFOR does not accept any violence. In a democratic society different opinions or conflicting positions have to be solved peacefully by discussions and negotiations.”

KFOR has been informed about the situation tonight and has alarmed a considerable amount of units to intervene if necessary. KFOR monitors the situation and KFOR troops are in the North of Kosovo and will help to contribute to deescalate tensions if this is necessary.
