### **Situation at Gate 1 and Gate 31 calm but not secure**

Last night and this morning the situation at Gate 1 (Boundary Crossing Point at Jarinje) and at DOG 31 (Boundary Crossing Point Bernjak/Brnjak) was calm. However the situation is neither secure nor stable.

Therefore the Gates remain closed and under KFOR control. The regulations for entry or exit at the Gates have not been changed.

In particular, small private cars may cross the boundary on their own risk. However they will be checked by KFOR and searched for weapons and other prohibited goods. Trucks are not allowed to enter. At Dog 31 in Bernjak/Brnjak controls are very strict because of security reasons.

KFOR invites all to respect those rules.

KFOR is committed to maintain the Safe and Security Environment and the Freedom of Movement all over Kosovo for all people.

KFOR expects that all people will restrain from using any form of violence in order to maintain a peaceful situation.
