KFOR continues to support EULEX in searching for criminals

For the third day, KFOR is supporting EULEX in investigating the crimes committed during the last weeks and searching for suspects allegedly involved in those criminal activities, especially the murder of the KP officer killed on July 26th in the area of Zubin Potok.

KFOR has deployed reinforced units in Zupce and Zubin Potok in order to give EULEX investigators and police officers a safe and secure environment for their work. The soldiers further will protect the peaceful population from the perpetrators and radicals who are responsible for the unrest and the crimes committed.

The search will continue until those responsible will face justice in order to ensure law and order as well as a safe and secure environment overall in Kosovo.

KFOR addresses all honest and peaceful people to cooperate with EULEX investigators and the soldiers who care for Safety and public order. People in the North are requested to support the security forces by informing them about the whereabouts of the alleged murders and criminals.
