KFOR provides more time to remove the roadblocks

COMKFOR Major General Erhard Drews has postponed the KFOR convoys to supply the KFOR troops at the boundary crossing points until Tuesday to allow more time to the citizens in the north of Kosovo to facilitate the removal of roadblocks.

The representatives of the municipalities of Leposavic, Mitrovica North, Zubin Potok and Zvecan asked for more time and COMKFOR has decided to give them an additional day. COMKFOR appreciates their willingness to open the roads for supplying KFOR troops at Gate 1 (Jarinje), Dog 31 (Brnjak) and Camp Nothing Hill.

KFOR's mission is to maintain a safe and secure environment as well as freedom of movement for all the people in Kosovo from all communities. KFOR will continue to do so firmly, carefully and impartially, in full compliance with our mandate.
