INCIDENTS IN NORTHERN KOSOVO

In accordance with its UN mandate, KFOR carried out this morning a Freedom of Movement operation in the municipality of Zubin Potok in Northern Kosovo. The operation was carried out in order to remove roadblocks. During the day, small arms fire and Molotov cocktails were used by violent individuals against KFOR soldiers. As a result, several KFOR soldiers were wounded. KFOR responded to these criminal acts using non-lethal means, (water cannons, rubber bullets, and tear gas).

Any action threatening a safe and secure environment is unacceptable. KFOR will take all appropriate measures to ensure the safety of all the people of Kosovo.

KFOR's mission is to contribute to a safe and secure environment in Kosovo which includes freedom of movement in accordance with its mandate, under United Nations Security Council Resolution 1244.. ,
