



Press statement about removal of roadblocks at Jagnjenica 2011-12-05

KFOR welcomes the opening of the roads in the Zubin Potok Valley.

The removal of obstacles by the population itself has been requested by KFOR for weeks already and therefore symbolizes a step forward.

KFOR, in order to accelerate the action, assisted in removing the gravel by using a bulldozer and an engineer tank.

However, KFOR does not measure actors by their words only, but by what is actually done.

To this day, for example, there are still piles of gravel at Bernjak (Gate 31) and Jarinje (Gate 1) on Serbian territory, hampering the freedom of movement of citizens in direction to the North.

As of today, there will be a joint KFOR and Kosovo Police Vehicle Check Point on the road between Zupce and Zvecan in order to ensure a safe and secure environment in Zubin Potok Valley.
