Grenades thrown at KFOR compound in DOG 31 **BRNJAK Crossing Point**

At 04:00am this morning two (2) hand grenades were thrown at the KFOR Compound in DOG 31 at the BRNJAK Crossing Point.

One exploded, the other remained unexploded in the middle of the road, blocking traffic. A KFOR Explosive Ordinance Disposal Team has been alerted.

One KFOR soldier has received slight hearing loss; no significant material damage has been reported.

For safety reasons and to facilitate ongoing investigations BRNJAK Crossing Point (DOG 31) will remain closed until further notice.

KFOR again condemns the totally unacceptable use of violence, which will be strongly opposed by KFOR.
