

# The Euro-Atlantic Partnership Council in 1997

The Euro-Atlantic Partnership Council (EAPC) was set up in 1997 to succeed the North Atlantic Cooperation Council (NACC). The EAPC consists of a new mechanism to provide a general opportunity for political negotiations on all aspects of NATO-Partner cooperation, for example Partnership for Peace (PFP) activities.
